

Lonesome Dove Spring Project Show

Family Living Project Fair

The show will take place in conjunction of the Lonesome Dove Spring Project Show. This is a prep event for PCLIA Youth Fair in June. We will follow similar rules to the PCLIA Youth Fair, but please note age divisions are different from what you will see at the County Fair event in June.

These are the general rules of the Lonesome Dove Spring Project Show: Family Living Division and the following rules will govern the LDS show.

1. Entries are \$5 (cash or check only) and will be entered at the same time as the project is turned in by 12:30pm on **Monday, April 25th**.
2. Senior, Intermediate, Junior & Clover divisions of each project category.
 - a. SR (9TH-12TH Grade), INT (6th-8th grade), JR (3rd-5th grade) & Clover (K-2nd Grade)
2. All projects must be in possession and executed by the exhibitor.
3. Exhibitors may enter unlimited entries in each division.
4. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
5. Exhibitor name & Age Division must be on the bottom or backside of each project.

- 7:30am-12:30pm - Check in of all Family Living project entries.
- 1:00pm- Judging will begin for all events.
- 4:00pm- Winners will be announced via email from the 4-H office.

Art

Photography

1. All photographs must be 8 inches by 10 inches in dimension. Color or black and white photographs are acceptable.
 - Photos do NOT need to be on foam board, we do recommend you put them in a large Ziploc or plastic sleeve for protection from the elements.
 - Photography in frames or mounted on frames will not be accepted.
- Slight computer enhanced photos are allowed such as crop, trimming, adjusting lighting, and red eye reduction. However substantially altered photography, such as changing colors or applying design styles, using computer graphics, filters, or Photoshop are not allowed.
- Name & Age division needs to be on a postcard attached to the back of the photo or protective covering.

Entries will be judged on the following:

- Technical merit, focus, sharpness, detail, depth of field, color, brightness, contrast, saturation, usage of light.
- Composition - does the photo clearly communicate the subject, is the photo balanced, does the photographer exhibit creativity through the photo.
- Impact - viewer's initial response to a stimulating image, does it has a WOW factor?

Non-Photography

1. All art entries must be entirely painted or drawn by hand.
 1. The use of canvas is permitted.
2. Entries must be original, not "paint by number".
3. Exhibitors must cover signatures on items entered for judging purposes. Name & Age division needs to be on a postcard attached to the back of the project.

Entries will be judged on the following:

- Entries will be judged on time and effort involved, quality of work, creativity, and good use of materials.

Leather Crafts

All leather craft project entries must consist of at least 85% leather. The remaining 15% of the project will consist of hardware, stain, paint, wood, etc., where applicable.

Entries will be judged on the following:

- Leathercraft: Judging will be based upon four (4) major criteria in this order:
 - a) percentage of carving, tooling, stamping or forming or any combination thereof
 - b) overall difficulty of the project
 - c) originality of the item

Food (Baked Goods)

Baked goods divisions as followed based on entries.

1. **All entries must be accompanied with the recipe at the time of check in.**
 - The recipe must be typed in black ink on one side of one 8 ½ x 11 sheet of plain, white printer paper with no clip art or photographs, colored ink or added decorations. The recipe must include the recipe name, all ingredients, including garnishes, along with all steps on how to prepare the baked good. The recipe shall not include the exhibitor's name.
2. All baked goods must be made from scratch.
3. The judges will taste all entries; therefore, food safety is critical.

Pies

Pies must be traditional pie entered in a non-decorative round aluminum foil pie pan and shall be one single pie with a pastry pie crust on the bottom. An additional pie crust on top is acceptable.

- Crust and filling must be made from scratch and the crust recipe must be included on the recipe sheet (Include ingredients and steps.)
- Name & Age division needs to be on a postcard attached to the bottom of pie pan.

Entries will be judged on the following:

Entries will be judged on outside appearance, crust, level of difficulty, and flavor.

Cakes

Cakes will be divided into three categories: Single Layer, Multi-Layer and Bundt cakes.

1. Except for decorated cakes, cakes must be on a disposable container, no larger than 12". Cakes must be securely covered with clear plastic wrap.
2. Except for decorated cakes, cake must be baked in an angel food cake pan, a Bundt pan or a round layer cake pan. No cake balls are allowed.
3. Please remember cakes must be made from scratch.
 - Name & Age division needs to be on a postcard attached to the bottom of pan.

Entries will be judged on the following:

- Entries will be judged on outside appearance, level of difficulty, and flavor.

Breads

Breads shall be one loaf or bread item unsliced, six muffins or six rolls presented on a paper plate, inside a plastic bag (wrapped in plastic wrap is acceptable). All breads must be made from scratch.

Entries will be judged on the following:

- Entries will be judged on outside appearance, crust, volume, texture, level of difficulty and flavor.

Cookies

Cookies should be drop, refrigerated or shaped. Ten (10) cookies will be presented on a paper plate inside a plastic bag. No bars, or cake balls. All cookies must be made from scratch.

Entries will be judged on the following:

- Entries will be judged on outside appearance, level of difficulty, and flavor.

Horticulture

Floral Arrangements

Floral arrangements may only be comprise of fresh cut floral material. Arrangements including containers may be no larger than 2'x2' (no minimum). Dried, silks, and painted plant materials will not be permitted.

Inspiration Table measurements: 47in. long, 17in. wide, and 31in. tall.

Entries will be judged on the following:

- Arrangements will be judged following the principles and elements of floral design.
